PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The District proposed Project included reactivation of Well 2, and installation a new nitrate removal treatment facility, operations building, and a pump assembly. Well 2 has been out of service for potable water use since 1976. The Project will include:

- A submersible pump and motor
- A small operations building with chlorination room and electrical room on a concrete pad
- A nitrate removal treatment facility within a covered area on the concrete pad
- Chlorination feed system with sodium hypochlorite solution
- Electrical system to power the pump and nitrate removal treatment facility
- Telemetry system to allow remote monitoring and control
- Above ground discharge piping with a flow meter to connect to Ordunio Reservoir
- Underground discharge piping to waste
- Asphaltic concrete paving and on-site improvements

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: This is to advise that the State Water Board has issued a drinking water supply permit 1910028-005 for the above described Project on June 19, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have significant effects on water quality.
2. A Negative Declaration (ND) was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
3. Mitigation measures were not made conditions of the issuance of this permit.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan was not adopted for this Project.
5. Findings were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this Project.
