**Project Title:** State Route 4 Wagon Trail Realignment (Basin Subprojects 8, 9, and 10) (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. CAL-36759-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at three locations near Black Creek (BC-1) and Black Creek tributaries (BC-2, BC-5, and BC-7) in the County of Calaveras, State of California along State Route 4 (SR-4) between the communities of Copperopolis and Angels Camp. The post miles for the Project are CAL-4 R10.3 – R16.4.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-36759-R2), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the California Department of Transportation.

The Project includes the construction of three permanent water detention basins and their outfalls. The three water detention basins are part of the larger realignment work of a 6.1-mile segment of SR-4 called the State Route 4 Wagon Realignment Project (1600-2020-0104-R2). Clearing, grubbing, excavation, backfilling, grading, compacting, and rock slope protection placement will be done near the stream channels and their associated riparian habitat.
