**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located at post miles CAL-4 R10.3 – R16.4, at Black Creek, Black Creek tributaries, and Nassau Creek tributaries in the County of Calaveras, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0104-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.
