Location: Santa Cruz Island, Santa Barbara County


Description: Replacement and relocation of the Scorpion Pier, in order to improve park operations, visitor experience, and safe access to Santa Cruz Island. The State Lands Commission action is an amendment of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through February 28, 2022.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on April 5, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Record of Decision was prepared by a federal agency under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and is being used in the place of an Environmental Impact Report pursuant to the provisions of CEQA (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251).
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the National Park Service (NPS), certified the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Record of Decision and approved the project on August 14, 2018. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIS as prepared for this project by NPS. The EIS and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
