

**Project Title:** Sammel Water Diversion and Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0616-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 1.2 miles northeast of the town of Honeydew, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 31, T2S, R1E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Bull Creek U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 107-054-018 latitude 40.2609 N and longitude 124.1127 W.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to two encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to the North Fork Mattole River. Water is diverted for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment will upgrade an existing rocked ford on a Class III stream. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
