**Project Title:** O'Hare Diversion Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0088-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 11 miles north and west of the town of Whitethorn, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 29, T3S, R1E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Honeydew U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 107-252-010 and 107-252-015; latitude 40.18307 N and longitude -124.0916 W at the point of diversion (POD).

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 1 encroachment. The encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed class II spring that is tributary to Honeydew Creek. Water is diverted for domestic household use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):


1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
