Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 1 air mile SW of Thorn Junction, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 05, T05S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 215-241-072; latitude 40.0524 N and longitude 123.9758 W at the point of water diversion.

Project Description: The project is limited to two (2) encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from Bridge Creek (up to 0.3 acre-feet annually) used solely for domestic purposes. Work for this stream crossing encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing culvert and associated fill prism followed by stream channel restoration as specified in the Notification.
