Project Title: Morton Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0465-R1)


Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 6 miles SE of the town of Harris, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 14, T05S, R05E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Jewett Rock U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 218-111-001; latitude 40.0277 N and longitude -123.5796 W at the stream crossing.

Project Description: The project consists of X encroachment(s): The project is limited to one encroachment (Table 1). The encroachment is to upgrade a stream crossing that was installed without 1602 notification and does not meet current standards. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with a new stream crossing, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
