Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 12, T3S, R1W, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Shubrick Peak U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle: Assessor's Parcel Number 107-153-01; latitude 40.2147 N and longitude -124.1314 W at the point of diversion (POD). Assessor's Parcel Number for Place of Use 107-106-06.

Project Description: The project is limited to 1 encroachment (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed spring to Bear Trap Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure.

The Notification discloses two existing ponds on APN:107-106-06. One is described as an historic concrete pond for aesthetic purposes. The other is a historic trout pond that was lined in 2016 and is used for agricultural irrigation. This pond is presented as rainwater catchment. CDFW did not conduct a site inspection and has not verified that these ponds are not hydraulically connected to surface water. Following a site inspection at a later date CDFW may recommend modifications if the ponds are found to adversely impact fish and wildlife resources.

No other projects that may be subject to FGC1602 were disclosed. This Agreement does not retroactively permit any stream crossings, water diversions or other encroachments not described above.
