**Project Title:** Kemp Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0281-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within the Salmon Creek watershed, approximately 3.8 miles southwest of the town of Myers Flat, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 2, T3S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 221-011-006; latitude 40.2240 N and longitude 123.9272 W at the point of diversion (POD).

**Project Description:** The project is limited to five encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from a pond. Water is diverted for irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The four other proposed encroachments will permit after the fact upgrades and new improvements to culverts at road/stream crossings. Work for these projects will include excavation, removal of the existing culvert, replacement with a new culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
