Project Title: King Water Extraction Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-06131-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 0.5 miles northeast of the town of Petrolia, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 3, T2S, R2W, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Petrolia U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 105-061-011; latitude/longitude: 40.3200, -124.2772 at the point of diversion (POD) for a hydraulically connected well.

Project Description: The project is limited to one encroachment (Table 1) for water diversion from a hydraulically connected well to the Mattole River. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure.

No other projects that may be subject to FGC1602 were disclosed. This Agreement does not retroactively permit any stream crossings, water diversions or other encroachments not described in Table 1 below.
