Project Title Lewis Water Diversion, Stream Crossings, and Pond Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0838-R1)

Project Location The project to be completed is located within the Redwood Creek and South Fork Eel River watersheds, approximately 4.2 miles west of the town of Redway, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 13, T4S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 220-331-001; latitude 40.1117 N and longitude 123.9108 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to five encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from a stream below an onstream pond. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The four other proposed encroachments will upgrade existing road/stream crossings and modify two pond impoundment structures to provide bypass flows for impounded water within the ponds. Culvert replacement, lowering of the spillway, or decommissioning of the two ponds will be evaluated based on the requested biological assessment and guidance from the Regional and State Waterboards. Work for these encroachments may include excavation, removal of culverts, replacement with new culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
