**Project Title:** Lewis Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0673-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Lower Eel River watershed, approximately 11.68 miles SE of the town of Garberville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 2, T05S, R05E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Jewett Rock U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 218-021-003; latitude 40.0550 N and longitude -123.5873 W at the first stream crossing.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to six encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Pipe Creek and associated pond spillway improvements. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The five other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized stream crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
