Project Title: Christenson Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0030-R1)


Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Van Duzen River watershed, approximately 6.5 miles east of the town of Bridgeville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 24, T01N, R04E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Larabee Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 210-250-010; latitude 40.45382 N and longitude 123.67432 W at the point of diversion.

Project Description: The project is limited to five encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from adjacent on-stream ponds that are unnamed tributaries to Butte Creek. Water is diverted for irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The four other proposed encroachments are to upgrade and/or decommission failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings (or decommissioning), backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.  
CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
