**SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108**

**Project Title:** Peek Sunny West Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0750-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 2.5 miles south of the town of Miranda, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Sections 14 and 23, T3S, R3E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Miranda U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 212-041-005 and 214-233-008.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to nine encroachments. The proposed encroachments are to upgrade informal and failing stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of road material, replacement with new properly sized culverts or armored fill crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
