

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Redwood Creek watershed, approximately 9 miles southwest of the town of Willow Creek, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 25, T6N, R3E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Maple Creek U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 316-172-019; latitude 40.8733 N and longitude 123.7739 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to six encroachments. Two encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Redwood Creek. Water is diverted for irrigation use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The four other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts and modify ponds constructed without permits or engineering. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts. backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
