Project Title: Ballard Water Diversions and Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0183-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 6 miles south east of the town of Garberville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 29, T5S, R4E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Harris U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel 223-034-003; latitude 40.028977 N and longitude 123.726285 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to 11 encroachments (Table 1). Seven of the encroachments are to upgrade or remove failing and undersized culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. One of these crossings will be decommissioned, and natural stream bed and bank restored. Four of the encroachments are points of diversion including a wooden spring box on a Class II stream, 2 perennial springs, and an onstream pond.
