Project Title: Carstensen Water Diversion and Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0063-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 4.5 miles west of the town of Miranda, County of Humboldt, State of California; Section 13, T3S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 219-011-008.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0063-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Devin Carstensen. The project consists of two encroachment(s): One encroachment is for water diversion from Mineral Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use. Work for this water diversion will include facility retrofit, use, and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment is to upgrade an undersized culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the undersized culvert, replacement with a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. A hydrologically connected aesthetic pond was also disclosed onsite; however, no modification is required at this time.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as in the Lead Agency / in a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
