**Project Title:** Hills Water Diversion and Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0729-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately SW miles 4.46 of the town of Miranda, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 19, T03S, R03E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 219-061-014; latitude 40.1916 N and longitude -123.8868 W at the point of diversion.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to seven encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to South Fork Salmon Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The six other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as in the Lead Agency / in a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
