PROJECT LOCATION

The project to be completed is located within the Upper Mainstem Eel River watershed, in Alderpoint, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 27, T3S, R5E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Alderpoint U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 216-271-019.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project is limited to 5 encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to the Upper Mainstem Eel River. Water is diverted for domestic use and agricultural use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The project is also to retroactively permit recently installed watercourse crossings and a water line crossing. The other proposed encroachment is to upgrade undersized stream crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing crossing, replacement with a new properly sized crossing, backfilling and compaction of fill.
