Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 6.4 miles SW of the town of Redway, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 14, T04S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 220-052-013 latitude 40.1111 N and longitude -123.9357 W at the first point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: This Agreement relies on the Notification materials a desk review without a CDFW site inspection. The project is limited to two encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed spring from North Fork China Creek tributary to China Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use only. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment is to maintain the existing 48" corrugated metal pipe culvert. It is described as showing some wear on the bottom but, is still serviceable for at least 5 years. No work for this encroachment is authorized for replacement, only maintenance. If work is required it cannot be considered under CDFG Code 1610 as an emergency. If work becomes necessary during the terms of this Agreement an amendment would become necessary to cover replacement.
