## **PROJECT LOCATION**

The project to be completed is located within the Kekawaka watershed, approximately 1.5 miles southwest of the Heartwood Institute, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 11, T5S, R5E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Jewett Creek U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 218-101-003, 218-101-002, and 1218-091-006.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project is limited to 7 encroachments. Two encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Kekawaka Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and agricultural use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The 5 other proposed encroachments are to upgrade undersized stre cro

stream crossings and realign a watercourse. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill.
