Project Description: The project consists of 3 encroachment(s): The project is limited to 3 encroachments. The first encroachment includes work to restore the stream to natural conditions from a historic unpermitted diversion in the form of a wooden slat dam. The second encroachment is for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Larabee Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment is to upgrade a failing and undersized stream crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
