Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within Blue Slide Creek and Miller Creek watershed, approximately 2.6 miles northwest of the town of Briceland, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 02, T04S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 220-292-015, 220-292-017, and 220-292-018; latitude 40.1386 N and longitude 123.9303 W at the project center.

Project Description: The project is limited to 19 encroachments on unnamed tributaries to Blue Slide Creek and Miller Creek. Nine encroachments are to upgrade existing stream crossings culverts and seven encroachments are to decommission and remediate unpermitted crossings or stream alteration work. Work for these encroachments will include some or all the following: excavation, culvert removal, culvert installation, backfilling and compaction of fill, rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion, reconstruction of the bed and banks of the stream, and
