The place of use for the points of diversion are located on two parcels Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 522-052-006 and adjacent APN 522-044-003. However, the adjacent parcel itself has only partially been evaluated by CDFW for projects subject to CDFG 1600 Code. Project Description: The project is limited to 6 encroachments. Two encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Brannan Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The 4 other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Geotextiles are prohibited material in streambed, bank, or channel.
