Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 5.8 miles Northwest of the town of Redway, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 25, T03S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 221-230-003; latitude 40.1718 N and longitude 123.9101 W at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to 12 encroachments to Hacker Creek and unnamed tributaries.
