Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 4.3 miles E/SE of the town of Bridgeville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located on Assessor's Parcel Number 210-044-002; latitude 40.447692 N and longitude 123.714332 W at the first point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to 10 encroachments. Two encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Little Larabee Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Three encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly designed crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Five encroachments are to decommission failing stream crossings and restore the stream channels.
