Project Title: Carl Water Diversion and Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0607-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Salmon Creek watershed, approximately 5.5 miles NW of the town of Redway, County of Humboldt, State of California; Section 19, T03S, R03E, Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 219-061-017 and 219-061-019; latitude 40.1892 N and longitude -123.8801 W at the point of diversion.

Project Description: The project is limited to 4 encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to South Fork Salmon Creek. Water is diverted for irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Two proposed encroachments are to upgrade existing stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, installation of new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. The fourth encroachment is the decommissioning of a cannabis cultivation site within a stream and to restore the area.
