Project Title: Finley Cal Fin Organics Water Diversion, Stream Crossings, and Pond Spillway Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. (1600-2019-0853-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 5.5 miles Southeast of the town of Harris, County of Humboldt, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 218-071-004; latitude 40.0295, N and longitude -123.6052W at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to 6 encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from a pond located within the Eel River Watershed. Water is diverted for irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure and improvement of the pond's spillway. The second encroachment includes work to disconnect surface flows to the pond and disconnect the pond's spillway from the stream. The 4 other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts. Encroachment 6, a stream crossing, is the existing spillway for point of diversion 2. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
