Project Title: Rolff Water Diversions, Stream Crossings and Pond Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0309-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located in the Mattole River watershed, approximately 3 miles northeast of the community of Ettersburg, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Sections 33 and 34, T03S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Ettersburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 221-181-007, 221-181-008, 221-181-016, 221-181-017, 221-181-018, 221-181-019, 221-181-020, and 221-181-026; latitude 40.1546 N and longitude -123.9355 W at the first point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to 25 encroachments (Table 1). Seven encroachments are for water diversion from unnamed tributaries to Blue Slide Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and cannabis irrigation. Work for the water diversions will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. Fifteen encroachments are to upgrade failing and/or undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Three onstream reservoirs (ponds) will receive work to the spillways and/or decommissioning. Pond 2, Pond 4 and Pond 5 are subject to the State Water Resources Control Board and CDFW Joint Procedures for Cannabis Cultivation Onstream Reservoirs. Cultivator shall apply for Cannabis Small Irrigation Use Registration for these ponds.
