The project is located in Section 23, T02S, R03E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Myers Flat U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 211-374-010-000; latitude 40.2834 N and longitude 123.8098 W at the pond outlet culvert. Project Description: The project is limited to one (1) encroachment. The encroachment is to improve the pond outlet culvert by installing rock armoring to minimize continued erosive potential when the pond overflows and to minimize the potential of delivering sediment to waters of the state. A class III stream begins approximately thirty (30) feet from the pond culvert outlet.
