Project Title: Arnold Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-29422-R1C)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Butte Creek watershed, approximately 6 1/3 miles southeast of the town of Bridgeville, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 26, T1N, R4E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Larabee Valley U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 210-071-004; latitude 40.4273 N and longitude 123.6898 W at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to three encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to Mule Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. One encroachment shall upgrade an existing culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culvert, replacement with a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. One encroachment shall remediate an altered stream channel and install a rocked ford crossing. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of fill and debris, recontouring the channel and road prism, installation of an appropriately designed rocked ford crossing, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
