**Project Title:** Tallac Creek Sewer Pipeline Long-Term Protection Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-29253-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at Tallac Creek, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; approximately centered at Latitude 38.943641, Longitude -120.070797 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number No. ELD-29253-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, South Tahoe Public Utility District.

To permanently protect an exposed sewer pipeline crossing in Tallac Creek, the Permittee is proposing to construct a rock grade control structure in Tallac Creek. The rock grade control structure is designed to be compatible with phased actions of the Taylor and Tallac Restoration Project, which is being led by the US Forest Service, Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. The proposed project utilizes a rock-lined chute design and biotechnical bank stabilization treatments including revegetation with willow cuttings. The project will result in 329 cubic yards of fill associated with the rock grade control structure.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
