Dear Mr. Lyon:

Enclosed is the final Streambed Alteration Agreement (Agreement) for the Lyon Estates Subdivision VTM #17950 (Project). Before the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) may issue an Agreement, it must comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). In this case, the Department, acting as a responsible agency, filed a Notice of Determination (NOD) within five working days of signing the Agreement. The NOD was based on information contained in the final Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the lead agency.

Under CEQA, the filing of a NOD triggers a 30-day statute of limitations period during which an interested party may challenge the filing agency's approval of the Project. You may begin the Project before the statute of limitations expires if you have obtained all necessary local, state, and federal permits or other authorizations. However, if you elect to do so, it will be at your own risk.
