DOCUMENT TITLE: North Davis Meadows Potable Water Connection Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: County Road 29 and County Road 99D, City of Davis, Yolo County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as North Davis Meadows Water Consolidation Project. The Project includes consolidation of the North Davis Meadows (NDM) community water system with the City of Davis water distribution system to address contaminant levels that exceed the maximum contaminate levels for nitrate and hexavalent chromium in the NDW drinking water. The Project activities involve installation of new water meters at each water service connection; installation of new hydrants to comply with local hydrant spacing requirements; and decommissioning of the North Davis Meadows Wells 1 and 2 and the 30,000-gallon water storage tank.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on December 14, 2023. The County of Yolo will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted for the Project.
