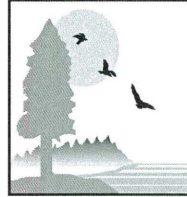

Title: Cayucos Sustainable Water Project Ocean Outfall

Proponent: Cayucos Sanitary District

Location: 4000 Highway 1, Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo County, CA 93442

Description: The Cayucos Sanitary District (District) will reuse an existing ocean conveyance pipe for treated effluent disposal. The project will include installation of a diffuser apparatus and a new high-density polyethylene pipe pulled through the existing structure. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 25-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through August 22, 2044.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on August 23, 2019, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Cayucos Sanitary District, adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring Program and approved the project on February 21, 2019. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by the Cayucos Sanitary District.
