Project Location: The Rio Vista Development Project (project) is located at several unnamed tributaries to the San Jacinto River, south of Nuevo Road, east of Dunlap Drive, and north of San Jacinto Avenue, in the Community of Nuevo, unincorporated Riverside County, California; Latitude 33.799573, Longitude -117.183320.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0179-R6 (Revision 1), pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Nuevo Road Properties, LLC represented by Eric Flodine.
