The physical improvements proposed include: Performing Arts Pavilion, cafe and restroom building, picnic areas, dog parks, plaza, playground, fountain, park office building, security lighting, landscaping, perimeter garden fencing, transportation network modification, pedestrian improvements including a Monument walk, and utility improvements. The project would also add additional events including, film festivals, concerts, farmer's markets, and similar events.
