**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-SBR-41789-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, the Inland Empire Utilities Agency (Permittee).

The Project is limited to the removal of a Southern California Edison pull box from a riparian-forested area and trimming of riparian trees adjacent to the area.
