Project Title: Collecting Canal Bridges CC-2 and CC-4 Replacement and Repair Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0123-R2)

Project Location (include county): This project consists of two locations (CC-2 Bridge and CC-4 Bridge) within Sutter County, California and within Sutter Basin.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an Amendment for Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2017-0123-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Water Resources.

The Project has been amended from replacing CC-2 Bridge and repairing CC-4 Bridge to include the full replacement of both CC-2 Bridge and CC-4 Bridge. This amendment results in elimination of temporary dewatering dams and a net reduction of ground disturbance by 0.01 acres.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
