Project Location (include county): The project is located at Strap Ravine, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.741944, Longitude -121.211111 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) previously executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2016-0258- R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Anthem United Homes, Inc.

The Applicant submitted a major amendment request to CDFW to modify the existing Agreement to include realignment of approximately 150 linear feet of stream channel at the location of the prefabricated bridge across Strap Ravine. This realignment will accommodate the stream flows and avoid the bridge footing being located within the active stream channel based on revised topographic modeling. Realignment of the stream channel will temporarily impact approximately 3,352 square feet.
