Project Description: An addendum to the Southern California Edison Transmission Tower Replacement Project (Project) Final EIR certified by the Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners in December 2017 has been prepared to evaluate minor technical modifications to the approved project proposed by Southern California Edison Company, comprised of: (1) Addition of ground improvements to the driven pile foundation design for the new towers M0-T2X (Pier S) and M0-T3X (Pier B) to combat the effect of

lateral spreading and allow driven piles to be viable at all locations. (2) A modification to Mitigation Measure BIO-4 to allow no more than 5 percent permanent loss of Southern Tarplant associated with construction activities, such as crushing by construction equipment, vehicles, or foot traffic. This 5 percent permanent loss is in addition to the no more than 10 percent temporary impacts of the on-site population on the south side of the Cerritos Channel.

In addition, a correction is made to Section 3.2.5.1 of the Final EIR to reflect the appropriate language in Special Condition 6.3.2.1 in Chapter 6 of the Application Summary Report. Text in the Final EIR Section 3.2.5.1 indicates that "removal of transmission towers would be completed outside of the nesting season (approximately February through August)". This text would be stricken as it is inconsistent with the correct language in Special Condition 6.3.2.1 in the Application Summary Report. Special Condition 6.3.2.1 does not preclude tower removal or construction during bird nesting season if the measures identified in the Special Condition are followed.

This is to advise that on May 27, 2020, as the Lead Agency, the City of Long Beach, acting by and through the Board of Harbor Commissioners adopted Resolution No. HD-20-344 approving the above-described modifications to the Final EIR for the Southern California Edison Tower Replacement Project and made the following determinations:

- 1. The modifications to the approved Project <u>will not</u> cause new significant impacts on the environment not identified in the previously certified Final EIR, or result in a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant impacts.
- 2. Mitigation measures were made conditions of the original approval of the Project.
- 3. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program <u>was</u> adopted for the original approval of the Project.
- 4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was adopted for the original approval for this Project.
- 5. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

In order to slow the community spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Port of Long Beach Administrative Building is currently closed to the general public. Therefore, hard copies of the record of the Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners' approval are not readily available to the general public at this time.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Southern California Edison (SCE) is proposing to replace a series of transmission towers across the Cerritos Channel, and raise approximately 5,000 feet of existing power lines, including a sub-transmission line, a 12kV distribution line, and fiber wrap; and remove a 220 kV transmission lines. The line would be replaced on new 400-feet tall towers that would provide the required safety clearance to allow for large-capacity cargo ships to navigate safely through the Cerritos Channel. The existing structures would be removed, modified, or abandoned. Existing underground utilities located in proximity to the existing and proposed new tower locations would be removed or modified.
