LEAD AGENCY AND ENTITY CARRYING OUT PROJECT: City of Live Oak (City)

RESPONSIBLE AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT: State Water Resources Control Board
(State Water Board)

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located in the southwestern portion of the city on Treatment Plant Access Road on a City-owned 39.24-acre site (APNs 06- 320-002, -003, -004).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Installation of a photovoltaic (PV) solar system to serve the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). The solar system will be located in two areas within the 39.24-acre WWTP facility site: (1) over the existing administration building and adjacent parking area, and (2) in a 4.6-acre vacant field at the northeast corner of the site. The project would include the installation of approximately 3,883 square yards of PV panels to produce approximately 864,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity per year. The Project will also replace 35 pole-mounted fixtures and 14 exterior wall packs with light-emitting diode heads.

This is to advise that the State Water Board made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations and approved CWSRF financing on December 3, 2019 for the Project:

1. Determinations were made pursuant to the CEQA.
2. The State Water Board considered the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) as prepared by the City for this Project.
3. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program was adopted by the City for this Project.
4. Mitigation measures were made a condition of the City's approval of the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the City for this Project.
6. The Project will not have any adverse significant water quality effects.
