The project would include student dining, wellness programming, study lounges, housing and offices for residential life staff, and replacement space for housing operations administrative staff currently located at Eucalyptus Point. In addition to housing, the project would also include general assignment classrooms, a permanent home for Marshall College academic and administrative programs, a consolidated home for the Economics Department, expansion space for the School of Global Policy and Strategy, and public realm and site utility infrastructure improvements.
