Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 6.9 miles northwest of the town of Willits, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Sections 20 & 21, T19N, R14W, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Burbeck U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute guadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 037-660-08; latitude 39.4913 N and longitude 123.4281 W at the first stream crossing (STX-1).

Project Description: The project is limited to four encroachments. One encroachment is for an impoundment of water on an unnamed tributary to Rowes Creek. Water is impounded in an on-stream pond by an existing dam for aesthetic use and recreation. One encroachment is to upgrade a failing and undersized culvert on the spillway of the on-stream pond. The two other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts. Work for these encroachments and the pond spillway will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

The Notification discloses additional features of interest. Two existing wells that are located within 10 feet of each other used for domestic water and irrigation. One well is shallow and is no longer in use. A hydrogeologic evaluation prepared by a licensed geologist for the wells in use was not provided for CDFW review.
