**Project Title:** Kurzfeld Water Diversion and Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0581-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Russian River watershed, approximately 7.2 miles northwest of the City of Ukiah, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 21/28, T16, R13, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Orrs Springs U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 151-260-11, 152-030-07 at the place of use (POU), 152-030-08 at the point of diversion (POD); latitude 39.2151 N and longitude -123.3129 W at the POD.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to three encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to York Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The two other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

The notification discloses additional features of interest. The first feature is an off-stream pond. The Notification discloses that this pond is not hydrologically connected with no evidence of channelized water. The pond was stated to be in good condition and meeting current standards. The pond that was disclosed in the Notification, but not included as 1602 project with a fee, is not covered under this Agreement. If maintenance (such as armoring) and/or replacement of the outlet culvert is necessary, that work may need to be covered under a major amendment or a separate Agreement if a field evaluation shows that the outlet connects to waters of the state.

The Permittee has disclosed a water well located at approximately 39.2210, -123.3071. The well's potential for hydraulic connectivity to streams was not addressed in the Notification by a professional hydrogeologist licensed in the state of California and the Department has not evaluated this well.

No other projects that may be subject to FGC1602 were disclosed. This Agreement does not retroactively permit any stream crossings, water diversions or other encroachments not described in Table 1.
