Project Title: Cassidy Water Diversion and Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0552-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Eel River watershed, approximately 4.5 miles northeast of the town of Laytonville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 20, T22N, R14W, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Laytonville U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Mendocino County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 033-120-06, 033-120-07, 033-120-08, and 033-120-22; latitude 39.748471 N and longitude -123.447216 W at the point-of-diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to two encroachments (Table 1). One encroachment is for water diversion from an unnamed tributary to Woodman Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include upgrades to the diversion infrastructure and use and maintenance of the water diversion. The other proposed encroachment will upgrade a failing and undersized culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing culvert, replacement with a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as in the Lead Agency / in a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
