**Project Title:** Taylor Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-06415-R1)

**Project Location (include county):** The project to be completed is located within the Russian River watershed at 24000 Fig Tree Lane in the town of Yorkville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located on Assessor's Parcels 049-230-21 and 049-230-38; latitude 38.916917 N and longitude 123.210077 W and latitude 38.916865 N and longitude 123.215055 W.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 8 encroachments (Table 1). Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
