Project Title: Poole Water Diversion Removal Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0330-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the South Fork Eel River watershed, approximately 2.25 miles south southeast of the town of Piercy, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 6, T24N, R17W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Piercy U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 053-160-15; latitude/longitude: 39.9542, -123.7762 at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The Agreement relies on the Notification materials and a desk review without a CDFW site inspection. The project is limited to one encroachment (Table 1) to decommission a Point of Diversion (POD) in McCoy Creek.

Table 1. Project Encroachments with Description

ID	Latitude/Longitude	Description
POD-1	39.9542, -123.7762	Permittee notified to decommission and cease using this Point of Diversion (POD) in McCoy Creek. The POD was previously used for domestic water needs and for irrigation of commercial cannabis.

The Permittee notified for a well located at Lat/Long 39.9533, -123.7763. This well is presented as the sole source of water for all needs on the property. CDFW determined that the water diversion proposed in the notification is not substantial due to the reliance on water storage for summer months. If the water diversion substantially changes, then the Permittee shall contact CDFW to determine if any minimization measures are required to be protective of fish and wildlife.

No other projects that may be subject to FGC section 1602 were disclosed. This Agreement does not retroactively permit any constructed reservoirs (including "ponds"), stream crossings, water diversions, modifications to riparian buffers, or other encroachments not described in Table 1. project is limited to seven (7) encroachments (Table 1). Two (2) encroachments are for water diversion from springs that are unnamed tributaries to Rancheria Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The five (5) other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts and replenish rock in failed rocked fords. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
