Project Title: Strazzabosco Stream Crossings and Onstream Reservoir Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0775-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Navarro River watershed, approximately 3.5 miles northwest of the town of Philo, County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 35, T15N, R15W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Philo U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 026-295-16.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0775-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Jason Strazzabosco. The project is limited to four encroachments (Table 1) for the use and maintenance of stream crossing infrastructure.

"Site 2"	39.1099, -123.4757	Use and maintenance of stream crossing. Crossing impounds a stream, forming a reservoir. Culvert conveys reservoir overflow.

The Notification discloses the use of two wells located at Lat/Long 39.1106, -123.4746 and 39.1114, -123.4748 respectively. These wells are presented as the primary source of irrigation water on the property. CDFW did not evaluate hydraulic connection of the wells to surface water, nor was a hydrogeologic evaluation prepared by a licensed geologist provided for CDFW review. The Notification also states that Sanchez Gardening and Landscaping makes approximately two- to three- 4,000-gallon water deliveries each week to supplement irrigation needs.

The Notification discloses an onstream reservoir located at approximately 39.1099, -123.4757, but proposes no diversion. CDFW could find no record of an Agreement authorizing the construction of this reservoir. The reservoir shall be subject to further evaluation by CDFW in coordination with State Water Resources Control Board Division of Water Rights. This Agreement authorizes no water diversion from the reservoir. Any proposed changes in the use of water from the reservoir will require a major amendment or separate Notification.
